- Candidate can apply for **GAT-B 2026 or BET 2026 or both through “Online” mode only. The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.**
- Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate, irrespective of whether they are applying for GAT-B 2026 or BET 2026 or both. However, a candidate applying for both the exams has to pay double Examination Fee as mentioned above. More than one Application i.e. multiple Application Forms submitted by a candidate will not be accepted.**
- Instructions for filling Online Application Form:**
 - ❖ Download Information Bulletin and read the same carefully regarding eligibility and procedure / documentation required for filling the Online Application Form.

❖ **Follow the steps given below to Apply Online:**

Step-1: Register for Online Registration using your own Email ID and Mobile No. and note down system generated Application Number.

Step-2: Complete the Online Application Form and note down the system generated Application Number.

Step-3: Upload legible scanned images of: (i) a recent photograph (in jpg/ jpeg file, size 10 kb – 200 kb) either in colour or black & white with 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background; (ii) candidate's signature (file size: 10kb - 50kb); (iii) PwD Certificate (file size 50 kb-300 kb) (iv) Identity Proof (file size: 10 kb – 200 kb) (v) Category Certificate (file size 50 kb-300 kb); (vi) Certificate of Proof of Date of Birth(file size 50 kb-300 kb); (vii) Certificate for Appearing/Result Awaiting Candidates (file size 50 kb-300 kb).

Step-4: Pay prescribed fee **through Net Banking / Debit Card / Credit Card / UPI** and keep proof of fee paid for future reference.

All the 4 Steps can be done together or at separate timings.

5. After the submission of Online Application Form (i.e successful completion of Step-4), Confirmation Page of the Application Form, should be downloaded and a printout of the same may be retained for future reference. The Confirmation Page of the online Application Form will be generated **only after successful payment by the Candidate.**

In case the Confirmation Page is not generated after payment of Prescribed Fee, then the candidate should approach the concerned Bank/Payment Gateway integrator (in the helpline number and email given in **APPENDIX- I** of the Information Bulletin), for ensuring the successful payment.

In spite of above, if successful transaction is not reflected on the Portal, it means transaction is not complete and candidate may pay second time and ensure OK status. However, any duplicate payment received from the candidate by NTA in course of said transactions will be refunded (in the same payment mode through which the duplicate payment is received), after fee reconciliation by NTA.

6. Information such as candidate's name, contact details / address, category, PwD status, educational qualification details, date of birth, choice of exam cities, etc provided by the candidate in the online Application Form will be treated as final. Any request for change in such particulars after the closure of correction period will not be considered by NTA.
7. *NTA does not edit/modify/alter any information entered by the candidate under any circumstances. Any request for change in information will not be entertained. Therefore, candidates are advised to exercise utmost caution for filling up correct details in the Application Form. **Request for corrections made by any candidates through Post/ Fax/WhatsApp/Email/by hand will not be entertained by NTA.***
8. *Candidates must ensure that email address and mobile number registered in the online Application Form are their own, as relevant/ important information/ communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the registered e-mail address and/ or through SMS on their registered mobile number only. NTA shall not be responsible for any non-Communication/miscommunication with a candidate in the email address or mobile number given by him/ her other than his/ her own.*
9. *NTA disclaims any liability that may arise to a candidate(s) due to incorrect information provided by them in their online Application Form.*
10. Candidates are advised to visit the NTA Website and check their e-mails regularly for latest updates.

Notes:

CHAPTER – 1: INTRODUCTION ABOUT NTA AND SPONSORING ORGANISATION

1.1. About National Testing Agency (NTA)

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), which is now known as Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India (GOI) has established the National Testing Agency (NTA) as an independent, autonomous, and self-sustained premier testing organization under the Societies Registration Act (1860) for conducting efficient, transparent and international standards tests in order to assess the competency of candidates for admissions to premier higher education institutions.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been entrusted by the Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB), Department of Biotechnology, Government of India, with the task of conducting of Graduate Aptitude Test – Biotechnology (GAT-B) 2026 and Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026.

Role of NTA is confined to registration of candidates for the examination, admitting them to examination, conducting the examination in the prescribed mode, display of answer keys and inviting challenges, finalizing the answer keys, processing the results and handing over the results to RCB.

1.2. About Department of Biotechnology, Government of India

The Department of Biotechnology (DBT) under the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India is the nodal agency for policymaking, promotion of R&D & manufacturing, infrastructure building and human resource development in Biotechnology in the country. Recognizing the critical need for nurturing skilled workforce for fueling the growth of biotechnology sector, DBT supports several biotechnology human resource development and capacity building programmes in the country.

1.3. About Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB)

Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB), an 'Institution of National Importance', has been established by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India under the auspices of UNESCO as a Category-II Centre. The mandate of RCB is to conduct research and impart education & training in the field of Biotechnology with a strong focus on capacity building. RCB is a part of the NCR Biotech Science Cluster (BSC) and operates in synergy with the other institutions in the Cluster. Since its formal beginnings in 2010, RCB has grown from strength to strength by accelerating efforts in multidisciplinary facets of biotechnology while initiating new research programmes as well as several educational and training activities.

Since the year 2020, Department of Biotechnology (DBT) has entrusted RCB as the Nodal Implementation Agency for management of key human resource development programmes through DBT-HRD Project & Management Unit (DBT HRD PMU).

RCB, on behalf of DBT, is managing DBT supported Post Graduate programmes in Biotechnology and Allied Areas and DBT - Junior Research Fellowship programme.

CHAPTER – 2: ABOUT THE EXAMINATIONS CONCERNED (GAT-B & BET – 2026)

2.1 Graduate Aptitude Test-Biotechnology (GAT-B) 2026

- 2.1.1 Graduate Aptitude Test-Biotechnology (GAT-B) is an All-India Entrance Examination to test the eligibility of bonafide Indian nationals for admissions to DBT supported Post Graduate programmes in Biotechnology and allied areas, at Participating Institutions/Universities in India. DBT supported Post Graduate programmes include: M.Sc. Biotechnology and allied areas; M.Tech. Biotechnology and allied areas; M.Sc. Agricultural Biotechnology and M.V.Sc. Animal Biotechnology.
- 2.1.2 **GAT-B 2026 Score is valid for admission to the above mentioned courses during the academic year 2026-2027 only.** Following declaration of GAT-B 2026 results, an all India category wise merit list will be prepared as per the Reservation Policy of Government of India. Call for admissions, for GAT-B 2026 qualified candidates, will be advertised separately by participating institutions/universities as per institutional admission and selection norms. **Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and will not be responsible for the admission & selection process (transfer/ cancellation/ conversion of seats/ fee refund policy) of participating institutions/ universities. Any disputes arising will be subject to Delhi jurisdiction only.**
- 2.1.3 Qualified candidates of GAT-B 2026, admitted to DBT supported Post Graduate programmes in Biotechnology and allied areas, at Participating Institutions/Universities in India will be paid stipend as under:
- M.Sc. Biotechnology & Allied Areas - Rs.5000/- per month
 - M.Sc. Agricultural Biotechnology - Rs.7500/- per month
 - M.Tech. / M.V.Sc. programmes - Rs.12000/- per month
- 2.1.4 Stipend will be disbursed through the participating institutions after due verification of students pursuing prescribed DBT supported Post Graduate programmes in Biotechnology and allied areas. Continuation of stipend for the second year of the programme is subject to satisfactory progress of the student, to be certified by participating institutions/ universities.
- 2.1.5 Details of participating institutions/ universities for GAT-B 2026 examination is given at **APPENDIX-II**. Applicants may regularly check the website of RCB, <https://rcb.res.in/> and <https://rcb.res.in/DBTPG/> for updated list of participating institutions/universities in GAT-B 2026.
- 2.1.6 Formats of various Attestation / Undertaking certificates required for registration for GAT-B 2026 entrance examination are provided in this Information Bulletin.
- 2.1.7 **Reservation Policy for GAT-B 2026**
- Reservation policy of Government of India will be followed for admissions of GAT-B 2026 qualified candidates to DBT supported Post Graduate Programmes in Biotechnology and allied areas at participating institutions/ universities. **Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and responsibility in the admission and selection process (transfer/ cancellation/ conversion of seats/ fee refund policy) of Participating Institutions/Universities.**
- 2.1.8 **Merit List generated under GAT-B 2026**
- Following declaration of GAT-B 2026 results, an all India category wise merit list will be prepared as per Reservation Policy of Government of India. Call for admissions, for GAT-B 2026 qualified candidates, will be advertised separately by participating institutions/universities as per institutional admission and selection norms. Reservation policy of Government of India will be followed for admissions to DBT supported Post Graduate Programmes in Biotechnology and allied areas at participating

institutions/universities. Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and responsibility in the admission and selection process (transfer/cancellation/conversion of seats/fee refund policy) of participating Institutions/Universities.

2.1.9 Transfer Policy for admissions under GAT-B 2026

Transfer policy in participating institutions/universities is as per institutional admission and selection norms. Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and responsibility in the admission & selection process of participating institutions/universities.

2.1.10 Conversion of Vacant Seats for admissions under GAT-B 2026

Conversion of vacant seats for admissions at Participating Institutions/Universities will be done as per institutional admission and selection norms. Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and responsibility in the admission and selection process of Participating Institutions/Universities.

2.1.11 Cancellation & Fee Refund Policy for admissions under GAT-B 2026

Cancellation and fee refund policy will be done as per institutional admission and selection norms. Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and responsibility in the admission and selection process of participating institutions/universities.

2.2 Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026

2.2.1 DBT-Junior Research Fellowship Programme

Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India grants fellowships to bonafide Indian citizens for pursuing Doctoral Research in Biotechnology and life-sciences through the "DBT-Junior Research Fellowship" (DBT-JRF) Programme. Initiated in the year 2004, the DBT-JRF Programme has played a critical role in nurturing skilled human resource capital and promoting research in frontier areas of biotechnology.

2.2.2 Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026

Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) is the national qualifying examination for award of Doctoral Research Fellowships under the DBT-Junior Research Fellowship (DBT-JRF) Programme. BET is an All-India computer-based examination which is held once every year. These fellowships are tenable at any recognized university/institution in India where the selected fellow registers for Ph.D. programme.

Based on the performance in Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026, two categories of merit list shall be prepared (Category-I and Category-II). Government of India norms for reservation will be followed for shortlisting of candidates. Candidates shortlisted under Category-I shall be eligible to avail fellowship at any recognized university/institution across India, where the candidate enrolls for Ph.D. Programme. Candidates shortlisted under Category-II will be eligible to be appointed in any DBT sponsored project with fellowship equivalent to NET/GATE qualification as per current DST guidelines and/or enroll in PhD programme, subject to selection through institutional selection process. Selection in Category-II shall not entitle candidate for any fellowship from DBT-JRF programme.

2.2.3 Details of Fellowship Award

Award of DBT-JRF Category-I fellowship entitles a shortlisted candidate for activation of fellowship subject to joining Ph.D. Programme and subsequent registration of Ph.D. from recognized University/ Institution across India within 2 years from the date of issuance of fellowship award letter. Such Category-I qualifying candidates will be eligible to avail fellowship grant under DBT-JRF programme. Emoluments under the fellowship grant includes research fellowship, contingency and house rent allowance (if applicable).

Registration for Ph.D. is candidate's responsibility and Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) or Department of Biotechnology (DBT) has no role/responsibility in this matter. Verification of documents shall be carried out for shortlisted candidates only. Award letter shall not be issued to candidates found ineligible or who submit incorrect documents or whose documents are not received within one (1) year from the date of declaration of BET 2026 result.

The candidates declared eligible for award of fellowship under DBT-JRF Programme will be governed by DBT-JRF Programme guidelines in this regard.

Formats of various Attestation / Undertaking certificates required for registration to BET 2026 entrance examination are provided in the Information Bulletin.

[Note: The information provided in this chapter (from point 2.1. onwards) have been received from RCB, DBT]

[Disclaimer: NTA will have no role in the selection process - transfer / cancellation / conversion of seats and admission of GAT – B 2026 and qualified candidates in the participating institutes / universities, refund of fees paid by them to Counselling Authorities/ Admitting Institutes / Universities, etc.]

CHAPTER – 3: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3.1 Graduate Aptitude Test-Biotechnology (GAT-B) 2026

3.1.1. Only bonafide Indian nationals are eligible to apply for GAT-B 2026. Candidates meeting the minimum **eligibility criteria** of Participating Institutions / Universities(**APPENDIX-II**) are eligible to apply for GAT-B 2026 entrance examination. Candidates may further verify the eligibility criteria on the website of the Participating Institutions/ Universities. Candidates who do not meet the minimum eligibility criteria of Institutions/Universities and still appear for GAT-B 2026 entrance examination will do so at their own risk. If at any stage it is found that a candidate does not fulfil minimum eligibility requirements of Participating Institutions / Universities, rules of cancellation or termination of respective Institutions / Universities shall be applicable. Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and responsibility in the admission and selection process (transfer/cancellation/conversion of seats/fee refund policy) of Participating Institutions / Universities.

3.1.2. Candidate who has either appeared or is due to appear in the final examination of their qualifying degree is eligible to apply for GAT-B 2026, under the result awaited(RA) category. Such candidate will have to submit the Undertaking/Attestation Form duly certified/stamped by the Head of the Institute (with address and name) from where the candidate is appearing for the qualifying degree. Failing to comply with this instruction will result in rejection of application. Attestation/Undertaking Form for appearing / result awaited candidates is given at **APPENDIX-III**.

3.2 Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026

3.2.1 Academic Qualification:

3.2.2 Candidates holding a 4-year/8 semester UG degree in Biotechnology/Life Sciences or allied disciplines such as Biomedical, Bioinformatics, Biochemistry, Biophysics, Botany, Chemistry, Computational Biology, Genetics, Microbiology, Zoology or any other allied areas of Biology/Life-Sciences.

3.2.2.1 For a 4 year/8 semester bachelor's degree (with research): minimum 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade as per NEP 2020. Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree Regulations, 2022, UGC to be followed.

3.2.2.2 For B.Tech and B.E degrees: with minimum 60% of marks for General, EWS & OBC category and 55% of marks for SC/ ST/ differently Abled candidates in aggregate (or equivalent grade).

3.2.3 Candidates holding a **Master's degree or equivalent** (M.Sc. /M.Tech. /M.VSc./ M.Pharm. /Integrated M.Sc./M.Tech./MBBS) in Biotechnology/Life Sciences or allied disciplines such as Biomedical, Bioinformatics, Biochemistry, Biophysics, Botany, Chemistry, Computational Biology, Genetics, Microbiology, Zoology or any other allied areas of Biology/Life-Sciences with minimum 60% of marks for General, EWS & OBC category and 55% of marks for SC/ ST/Differently Abled candidates in aggregate (or equivalent grade).

3.2.4 Final-year candidates or those awaiting results are eligible to apply for BET 2026, under the result awaited (RA) category. Such candidate will have to submit the Undertaking/Attestation Form duly certified/stamped by the Head of the Institute (with address and name) from where the candidate is appearing for the qualifying degree. Failing to comply with this instruction will result in rejection of application. Certificate for Appearing / result awaited candidates is given at **APPENDIX-III**.

3.2.5 **Age Limit:** Upto 28 years of age as on the last date of application for General & EWS category. Age relaxation of up to 5 years (33 years) for SC/ ST/ Differently Abled/ Women candidates and upto 3 years (31 years) for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates.

3.2.6 **Nationality:** Candidate should be a bonafide citizen and resident of India.

The Examinations will be conducted in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode.

The medium of Question Papers for both the examinations shall be **English only**.

4.4 Marking Scheme of Examinations

4.4.1 Graduate Aptitude Test-Biotechnology (GAT-B) 2026

The Question Paper for GAT-B 2026 Entrance Examination will consist of two sections:

- **Section A:** Section A will have 60 compulsory multiple choice questions of the level of 10+2 in the subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology. **Each question carries One (1) mark. There will be negative marking and for each incorrect response, half (1/2 or 0.5) mark will be deducted from the total marks.**
- **Section B:** Section B will have multiple choice questions of Bachelor's (Graduate) level requiring thinking and analysis. There will be questions from Basic Biology, Life Sciences, Biotechnology and allied areas as per the syllabus of GAT-B 2026. There will be 100 questions out of which candidates will have to attempt 60 questions. **Each question carries Three (3) marks. There will be negative marking and for each wrong response, One (1) mark will be deducted from the total marks.**

Note:

- In case more than one option is correct in a question, marks will be awarded to only those who marked any of the correct answers.
- If none of the options is found correct or a Question is found to be wrong then the Question will be dropped. The reason could be due to human error or technical error. Full marks may be awarded to those who have attempted such question.

4.4.2 Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026

The Question Paper for BET 2026 Examination will consist of two sections:

- **Section-A** will have 50 compulsory multiple choice questions in the subjects: General Science, Mathematics, Chemistry, General Aptitude, Analytical, Quantitative Ability and General Biotechnology. **Each question carries 03 (Three) marks. There will be negative marking and for each incorrect response, 01 (one) mark will be deducted from the total marks. Un-answered/un-attempted questions will be given Zero (0) marks.**
- **Section-B** will have 150 multiple choice questions of specific areas of Biotechnology and the candidate has to attempt 50 questions. **Each question carries 03 (Three) marks. There will be negative marking and for each incorrect response, 01 (one) mark will be deducted from the total marks.**

Note:

- In case more than one option is correct in a question, marks will be awarded to only those who marked any of the correct answers.
- If none of the options is found correct or a Question is found to be wrong then the Question will be dropped. The reason could be due to human error or technical error. Full marks may be awarded to those who have attempted such question.

4.5 Timings of Examinations

The examinations will be conducted in a single shift for a duration of 180 minutes / 3 hours.

CHAPTER – 5: FACILITY FOR PwD/ PwBD CANDIDATES

5.1. The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016:

The Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part-II Section 1, Ministry of Law And Justice (Legislative Department) New Delhi dated 28 December 2016 on “The Rights of Persons With Disabilities Act, 2016. The relevant paragraphs of the above Gazette Notification for consideration are as under: - Chapter -1.

Para 2(r), “persons with benchmark disabilities” (PwBD) means a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority.

Para 2 (s) “Persons with Disability (PwD)” means a person with long term physical, mental, intellectual, or sensory impairment which, in interaction with barriers, hinders his full and effective participation in society equally with others.

Para 2 (zc) “specified disability” means the disabilities as specified in the schedule (**Annexure I**).

5.1.1 Office Memorandum dated 29 August 2018:

Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, Office Memorandum No. F. No.34- 02/2015-DD-III dated 29 August 2018 for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the RPwD Act,2016. The relevant paragraphs of the above Office Memorandum for consideration are as under: -

Para IV. The facility of Scribe/Reader/Lab Assistant should be allowed to any person with benchmark disability as defined under section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016 and has limitation in writing including that of speed if so desired by him/her.

In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arm affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe/reader/lab assistant shall be given, if so desired by the person.

In case of other category of persons with benchmark disabilities, the provision of scribe/reader/lab assistant can be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution.

In case the candidate is allowed to bring his own scribe, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination. The person opting for own scribe should submit details of the own scribe as per proforma at **Annexure-II (more than 40%)**.

5.1.2 Office Memorandum dated 10 August 2022:

Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, Office Memorandum No F. No.29-6/2019-DD-III dated 10 August 2022 for conducting written examination for persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of Section 2(s) of the RPwD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of Section 2(r) of the said Act, i.e. person having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing. The relevant paragraphs of the above Office Memorandum for consideration are as under: -

Para 3 (b). The facility of scribe and/or compensatory time shall be granted solely to those having difficulty in writing subject to production of a certificate to the effect that person

concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government healthcare institution as per proforma at **Annexure-III**.

Para 3 (c). The medical authority for the purpose of certification as mentioned above should be a multi-member authority comprising the following: -

- i. Chief Medical officer/Civil Surgeon /Chief District Medical Officer, Chairperson
- ii. Orthopedic/PMR specialist
- iii. Neurologist, if available*
- iv. Clinical Psychologist/Rehabilitation Psychologist/ Psychiatrist/Special Educator Occupational therapist, if available*
- v. Any other expert based on the condition of the candidate as may be nominated by the Chairperson.

(* the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Chief District Medical Officer may make full efforts for inclusion of neurologists, occupational therapist from the nearest District or the Medical College/Institute, if the same is not available in the District)”

The candidate should fill up the details of scribe as per undertaking proforma Annexure II (Less than 40%).

5.2 Scribe and Compensatory Time

1. The candidate should have the discretion of opting for his own scribe / reader / lab assistant or request the Examination Body for the same. The examining body may also identify the scribe / reader / lab assistant to make panels at the District / Division / State level as per the requirements of the examination. In such instances the candidates should be allowed to meet the scribe two days before the examinations so that the candidates get a chance to check and verify whether the scribe is suitable or not.
2. The word “extra time or additional time” that is being currently used should be changed to “compensatory time” and the same should not be less than 20 minutes per hour of examination for persons who are allowed use of scribe / reader / lab assistant. All the candidates with benchmark disabilities who are eligible for availing the facility of scribe in terms of guidelines vide para IV of Para 4.1.1 above may be allowed additional time of minimum of one hour for examination of 3 hours duration whether they use the facility of scribe or not. In case the duration of the examination is less than an hour, then the duration of additional time should be allowed on pro-rata basis. Additional time should not be less than 5 minutes and should be in the multiple of 5”.

Note – Both the guidelines i.e. dated 29 August 2018 (for PwBDs) and dated 10 August 2022 (for PwDs) have other important aspects such as allowing use of assistive devices, proper seating arrangement, accessibility of examination centres etc. which will be followed.

The scribe will help the Candidate in reading the questions and / or keying in the answers as per the directions of the Candidate. A scribe will NEITHER explain the questions NOR suggest any solution to the Candidate.

It is to be noted that the Scribe will be provided by the National Testing Agency (NTA), if requested by the Candidate.

If it is found at any stage that a candidate has availed the services of a scribe and/or availed the compensatory time but does not possess the extent of disability that warrants the use of a scribe and/or grant of compensatory time, the candidate will be excluded from the process of evaluation, ranking, counselling and admission. In case such a candidate has already been admitted to any Institution, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.

Disability certificate/Unique Disability Identification (UDID)) issued by the notified medical authority needs to be uploaded in the Online Application Form of GAT-B/BET 2026.

Note: The NTA does not guarantee any change in the category or sub-category (PwD/PwBD status) after the submission of the Online Application Form, and in any case, no change will be entertained by NTA after the declaration of NTA Score for GAT-B/BET 2026. The category/sub-category (PwD/PwBD status) entered in the GAT-B/BET 2026 Database by the candidate will be used as final.

Therefore, the candidates are advised to fill in the category/sub-category column very carefully.

Note: The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

Note: Candidates must note that the benefit of reservation will be given to them subject to verification of documents. If it is discovered at any stage that a candidate has used a false/fake/incorrect document or has furnished false, incorrect or incomplete information, in order to avail the benefit of reservation, then such a candidate shall be excluded from all admission processes. In case such a candidate has already been given admission, the admission shall stand cancelled.

In the case of the Institutes run/aided/recognized by State Governments, the reservation policy of the respective State Governments shall be applicable.

CHAPTER – 6: Registration and Application Process

6.1 Ready Reckoner:

Before beginning the process of filling the Online Application Form, read Information Bulletin carefully, keep ready required documents and follow the instructions as mentioned at the beginning of the Application Form:

- ❖ Your Mailing Address as well as Permanent Address with Pin Code
- ❖ **Four cities** for Centres of your choice
- ❖ Category Certificate, if applicable
- ❖ Result Awaited Certificate, if applicable
- ❖ Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Certificate, if applicable
- ❖ Person with Disability (PwD/PwBD) Certificate, if applicable
- ❖ e-mail address and Mobile Number of candidate
- ❖ Scanned images in **JPG/JPEG format only.**

Candidate’s Signature in running hand	File size must be between 10 kb to 50 kb.

6.2. Instructions for filling Online Application Form

- 6.2.1 Candidates have to apply “Online” ONLY for GAT-B/BET 2026 by accessing the website: <https://exams.nta.nic.in/gat-bet/> (The Application other than online mode would not be accepted in any case). The entire application process of GAT-B/BET 2026 is online, including uploading of scanned images, Payment of Fees and Printing of Confirmation page. Therefore, candidates are not required to send/submit any document(s) including Confirmation page to NTA through Post/Fax/By Hand/E-mail.
- 6.2.2 If a candidate submits multiple Application Forms for the same course, only the first one will be considered and all others will be rejected automatically.
- 6.2.3 Replica of Application Form is given at Appendix-VI.
- 6.2.4 Information Bulletin and Replica of Application Form given therein may be downloaded and read carefully by the candidate to be sure about his/her eligibility and be familiar with the requirements for submission of Online Application Form.
- 6.2.5 To avoid correction in the particulars at a later stage, the candidate should exercise utmost caution while filling up the details in the Application Form.
- 6.2.6 Following Steps may be followed to Apply Online:

Step-1: Read the instructions at the beginning of the application form & Register for Online Form submission using your (candidate’s) own Email ID and Mobile No. and note down system generated Application Number.

Step-2: Complete the Online Application Form and Upload scanned images of (i) a recent photograph (in jpg/ jpeg file, size 10 kb – 200 kb) either in colour or black & white with 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against white background; (ii) candidate’s signature (file size: 10kb - 50kb); (iii) PwD Certificate (file size 50 kb-300 kb) (iv) Identity Proof (file size: 10 kb – 200 kb) (v) Category Certificate (file size 50 kb-300 kb); (vi) Certificate of Proof of Date of Birth (file size 50 kb-300 kb); (vii) Certificate for Appearing/Result Awaiting Candidates (file size 50 kb-300 kb).

Step-3: Pay prescribed fee **through Net Banking / Debit Card / Credit Card / UPI** and keep proof of fee paid for future reference.

6.2.7 All the 3 Steps can be completed in one go or each step completed at a time, saved, and the next completed later. The final submission of Online Application Form will remain incomplete if Step - 2 and Step– 3 are not completed, such Application Forms will stand rejected and no correspondence on this account will be entertained.

After the submission of Online Application Form (i.e. successful completion of Step-3), Confirmation Page of the Application Form, should be downloaded and a printout of the same may be retained for future reference. The Confirmation Page of the online Application Form will be generated only after successful payment by the Candidate.

In case the Confirmation Page is not generated after payment of Prescribed Fee, then the candidate should approach the concerned Bank/Payment Gateway Integrator (in the helpline number and email given in Appendix-I of the Information Bulletin), for ensuring the successful payment.

Despite the above, if successful transaction is not reflected on the Portal, it means the transaction is not complete, and the candidate will have to make the payment a second time and ensure confirmation of payment/OK status. However, any duplicate payment received in course of said transactions, by NTA, at the fee reconciliation stage, will be refunded to the candidate in the same payment mode through which the duplicate payment is received.

Notes:

- i. No request for refund of fee once remitted by the candidate will be entertained.
- ii. Candidates are advised to keep visiting the NTA’s website regularly for latest updates and to check their e-mails.
- iii. The NTA can make use of the data generated for the purpose of research and analysis.
- iv. All the candidates who have submitted the online Application and paid the Examination fee till last date will be allowed to appear in GAT-B/BET 2026 and their admit cards will be uploaded on the website.
- v. The certificates of educational qualification and category (if applied under reserved category) will be verified by the concerned institution. The candidates are, therefore, advised to ensure their eligibility and the category (if applying under reserved category).
- vi. NTA will, in no way, be responsible for any wrong/incorrect information furnished by the candidate(s) in his/her Online Application Form. The letter/e-mails/WhatsApp Message/Public Grievance in this regard will not be entertained by the NTA.
- vii. Candidates are advised to retain their Admit & Score Cards for future reference.

6.3 Choice of Cities for Examination Centre

6.3.1 List of Cities for Examination Centres for GAT-B/BET 2026 are given at Appendix-IV A/IV B. It is mandatory for candidates to select four cities (as 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th choice) of their choice while filling Online Application Form.

6.3.2 All efforts will be made to allot a Centre of Examination to a candidate in a City of his/her Choice, in order of preference. However, due to logistic & administrative reasons, exam centre may be allotted to him/her in a different city of nearby area.

6.3.3 The City for Examination Centre once chosen and allotted cannot be changed (after the closing of the correction window) and any request in this regard will not be entertained.

6.4 Procedure for Filling Application Form

PART I: REGISTRATION PAGE

Fill in the basic information and note down the system generated Application No.

1. Candidate's Name/ Mother's Name/ Father's Name: Provide Candidate's Name, Mother's Name, and Father's Name as given in the Secondary School Examination or equivalent Board / University Certificate in capital letters. No prefix in the name of the candidate is allowed.
2. Date of Birth: dd/mm/yyyy Provide Candidate's date of birth as recorded in Secondary School Examination or equivalent Board/University Certificate.
3. Mobile Number and e-mail Address: Candidates must provide own Mobile Number and e-mail address as the same may be validated. The candidate must ensure that email address and mobile number provided in the Application Form are their own (which cannot be changed later) as communication may be sent by e-mail or SMS.

Note: Only one e-mail address and one Mobile Number are valid for one application.

PART II: FILL IN THE COMPLETE APPLICATION FORM

Fill in the complete Application

1. The application particulars entered can be edited before final submission of the Application Form.
2. Once finally submitted, particulars in certain specific fields may be changed only during correction window. After that no communication in this regard would be entertained.
3. **All the steps for submission of Online Application Form, Uploading of Candidate's photograph, Candidate's signature, Documents (if applicable), Payment of fee and Printing of Confirmation Page can also be done separately. The Application Form can be saved as a Draft, at each stage, and can be filled later (before the last date).**
4. Facility of submission of Online Application Form, uploading of photograph, signatures, payment of fee and printing of the Confirmation Page will be deactivated as per schedule for submission of Application Form. Hence, candidates are required to complete the process within the prescribed schedule.
5. Candidates are not required to send/ submit hard copy of Confirmation page to NTA office. However, the candidates are advised to retain the hard copy of the Confirmation Page, and a proof of fee submitted for future need.
6. Registration will be treated as complete only if the fee has been transacted successfully, else the form will be cancelled.
7. **Other Backward Classes (OBC)-Non Creamy Layer is as per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website (www.ncbc.nic.in). Thus, the candidates falling in this list may mention OBC in the Category Column. State list OBC Candidates who are not in OBCNCL (Central List) may choose General (EWS) in case they fulfill the prescribed requirements in this regard.**
8. Gender- Provide Candidate's gender as recorded in the Type of Identification viz. Passport Number/ Ration Card/ Other Govt. ID.
9. Provide complete postal address with PIN Code (Mailing Address as well as Permanent Address) for further correspondence. PIN code of Correspondence Address should be given in the space provided for this purpose.

Notes:

- a. The NTA shall not be responsible for any delay/loss in postal transit or for an incorrect Correspondence address given by the Applicant in the Application Form. - **If it is found that the photograph uploaded is fabricated i.e. de- shaped or seems to be hand-made or computer made, the form of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using unfair means and the candidate would be dealt with accordingly.**
- **The photograph need not be attested.**

Note: Passport size photograph is to be used for uploading on Online Application Form and also for pasting on Attendance Sheet at the Examination Centre.

- The candidate should scan his/her passport size photograph for uploading. File size must be between **10 kb to 200 kb** (in JPG/JPEG Format only).

(ii) Candidate's Signature:

The candidates are required to upload the full signature in running hand writing in the appropriate box given in the Online Application Form. Writing full name in the Box in Capital letters will not be accepted as signature and the Application Form would be rejected.

- The candidate should put his/her full signature on white paper with Blue/Black Ink pen and scan for uploading.
- File size must be between **10 kb to 50 kb** (in JPG/JPEG Format only).

(iii) PwD/PwBD Certificate: to be uploaded (if applicable)

- File size must be between **50 kb to 300 kb** (in PDF Format only).

(iv) Identity Proof : to be uploaded (if applicable)

- File size must be between **10 kb to 200 kb** (in JPG/JPEG Format only).

(v) Category Certificate: to be uploaded (if applicable) (Annexure IV, V, VI,VII)

- File size must be between **50 kb to 300 kb** (in PDF Format only).

(vi) Certificate of Proof of Date of Birth : to be uploaded

- File size must be between **50 kb to 300 kb** (in PDF Format only).

(vii) Result Awaited Attestation Form: to be uploaded (if applicable) (Appendix III)

- File size must be between **50 kb to 300 kb** (in PDF Format only).

Note: Candidate must ensure that the uploaded images are clear and proper.

PART IV: Payment of Examination Fee

Pay prescribed fee through **Net Banking / Debit Card / Credit Card / UPI** and keep proof of fee paid for future reference. Please see **Appendix-I** for details.

PART V: Check List for filling the Online Application Form

The candidates are advised to ensure the following points before submitting the Online Application Forms:

- (a) Whether they fulfill the eligibility conditions for the Test as prescribed under the heading ‘**Eligibility Criteria**’ and ‘**Age Limit**’.
- (b) That they have selected their **category** viz General/ General-EWS/ OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/ SC/ ST/ PwD/ PwBD/ Third gender and Minority option, in the relevant column correctly.
- (c) That they have filled their **Subject and City of examination** in the relevant column correctly.
- (d) That Candidates with Disability (PwD/PwBD) have correctly filled the relevant column in the Online Application Form. Only PwD/PwBD candidates have to fill this column and the others have to leave it blank.
- (e) That they have kept a printout of Application Form (Confirmation Page) for their own record, to be produced, at a later stage, if required.

6.5 Important Points to Note:

The Candidates should fill their complete postal address with PIN Code for further correspondence.

The Candidate must ensure that e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form is his/her own (which cannot be changed later) as all communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail and/or SMS.

Online Application Form cannot be withdrawn once it is submitted successfully.

Application Form of candidates who do not fulfil the eligibility criteria shall be rejected.

In case a candidate is found providing incorrect information or the identity is proved to be false at any time in the future, the candidate shall face penal action as per the law.

Candidates are advised to retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence:

❖ Printouts of the Confirmation Page of Online Application Form.

❖ Proof of fee paid

❖ Photographs (same as uploaded on the Online Application Form) – 6 to 8 passport size photographs (for pasting on the Attendance Sheet at the Examination Centre).

The name on the photo identification must match with the name as shown on the Admit Card. If the name has been changed due to events such as marriage, candidate must show the relevant document at the time of exam. The relevant documents are - Marriage Certificate / Divorce /Decree / Legal Name Change Document / Gazette Notification.

Provision of Reservation for candidates belonging to EWS/ OBC/ SC/ ST/ PwD/PwBD will be as per GoI instructions issued from time to time.

The Aadhaar number is only one of the types of identification and is not mandatory. Candidates can also upload details of other IDs such as Passport, Ration Card, or any other valid Government identity.

candidate can fill only one application. If a candidate submits multiple Application Forms for the same course, only the first one will be considered, and all the others will be rejected automatically.

CHAPTER – 7: Admit Card, Instructions and Prohibited Materials

7.1 Admit Card for the Examinations

- 7.1.1 The Admit Card will be issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to their satisfying the eligibility conditions.
- 7.1.2 The candidate has to download the Admit Card from the NTA website and appear for the Examination at the given Centre on Date, timing and Examination as indicated in their Admit Card. Candidate may please note that Admit Cards will not be sent by post.
- 7.1.3 No candidate will be allowed to appear at the Examination Centre, on Date and timing other than that allotted to them in their Admit Card.
- 7.1.4 In case candidates are unable to download Admit Cards from the website, they may approach the Help Line between 09:30 am and 5:30 pm or write to NTA at dbt@nta.ac.in.
- 7.1.5 The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card carefully and follow them during the conduct of the Examination.
- 7.1.6 **In case of any mismatch in the particulars of the candidate or his/her photograph/signatures shown in the Admit Card and that of Confirmation Page, the candidate may immediately approach the Helpline between 09:30am and 5:30 pm.**

Notes:

- a. Under no circumstance, a duplicate Admit Card for GAT-B/BET 2026 will be issued at the Examination Centres.
- b. Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- c. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
- d. No Admit Card shall be issued to the candidates whose Applications are found to be incomplete for any reasons (including indistinct/ doubtful photographs/unsigned Applications) or who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria for the examination.
- e. Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of admission process.

7.2. Important Instructions for Candidates

- 7.2.1 The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Admit Card carefully and follow them strictly.
- 7.2.2 Candidates MUST bring the following documents on the day of Examination at the test centre. Candidates who do not bring these will not be allowed to appear in the Examination.
- i. Print copy of Admit Card downloaded from NTA website.
 - ii. One passport size photograph (same as uploaded on the Online Application Form) for pasting on the specific space in the attendance sheet at the Centre during the Examination.
 - iii. Any one of the authorized Govt. photo IDs (must be original, valid and non- expired), viz. PAN card/ Driving License/ Voter ID/ Passport/ Aadhar Card (With photograph)/ Aadhar Enrolment No/ Ration Card.
 - iv. PwD/ PwBD certificate issued by the Competent Authority, if claiming the relaxation under PwD/ PwBD category.

If the name has been changed due to events such as marriage, candidate must show the relevant document at the time of exam. Marriage Certificate/ Divorce/ Decree / Legal Name Change Document.

- 7.2.3 Candidates should not be in possession of any material listed in the list of prohibited material.
- 7.2.4 Candidates are not allowed to carry any baggage inside the Examination Centre. NTA will not be responsible for any belongings stolen or lost at the premises.

7.2.5 The candidates shall report at the Examination Centre at the time mentioned on the Admit Card to avoid crowding at the Examination Centre.

7.2.6 Candidates must reach the test centres on or before the reporting time. Entry of the candidates into centre shall be stopped 30 mins before the start of the Examination.

7.2.7 **Candidates may note that late entry to the Examination premises is not permitted under any circumstances.** NTA shall not be responsible for any delayed arrival of the candidate in reaching the centre due to any reason.

Candidates are advised to familiarize themselves with the location of test centre and plan travel time accordingly.

7.2.8 Biometric information of all the candidates shall be captured. Identity checks will be made upon arrival at the test centre to ensure that there are no unauthorized candidate is appearing for the test. Candidates are required to cooperate with the security personnel for security checks.

7.2.9 The candidate must show, on demand, the Admit Card for entry in the Examination room/hall. A candidate who does not possess the valid Admit Card shall not be allowed to enter the Examination Centre.

7.2.10 Candidates should take their allotted seat immediately after opening of the Examination Hall. If not, they are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the Examination Rooms/ Halls. NTA shall not be responsible for any resultant delay.

7.2.11 Any candidate found to have changed room/ hall or the seat on his/her own other than allotted would be considered as a case of unfair means and the candidature shall be cancelled and no plea would be accepted.

7.2.12 The candidate must sign and paste the photograph on the Attendance Sheet at the appropriate place.

7.2.13 The candidate should ensure that the question paper available on the computer is as per the opted Examination indicated in the Admit Card. In case, the subject of question paper is other than the opted Examination, the same may be brought to the notice of the Invigilator concerned immediately.

7.2.14 **All calculations/writing work are to be done only in the rough sheet provided at the centre in the Examination Room/ Hall and on completion of the test candidates must hand over the rough sheets to the invigilator on duty in the Room/ Hall.**

7.2.15 No candidate, without the special permission of the Centre Superintendent or the Invigilator concerned, will leave his/ her seat or Examination Room/ Hall until the full duration of the paper is over. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as instructed by the Centre Superintendent/Invigilators.

7.2.16 Please note that only registered candidates will be allowed at the Examination Centre. Friends or relatives accompanying the candidates shall not be allowed entry in the test centre under any circumstances and will not be allowed to contact the candidate while the Examination process is going on.

7.2.17 **Candidate shall appear at their own cost at the Centre on Date and time as indicated on their Admit Card issued by the NTA.** No TA, DA or any accommodation facility will be admissible for appearing in GAT-B/BET-2026 examination.

7.2.18 The candidates are governed by the Rules and Regulations/Instruction of the NTA with regard to their conduct in the Examination Hall. All cases of unfair means will be dealt with as per rules.

7.2.19 Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates will be further debarred from appearing in Examinations conducted by NTA.

7.2.20 NTA reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently if any, to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the GAT-B/BET 2026 even though the Admit Card had been issued by the NTA.

7.2.21 In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/ terms/ rules/ criteria regarding determination of Eligibility/ Conduct of Examination/Registration of Candidates/ Information contained therein, the interpretation of the DBT/ NTA shall be final and binding.

7.3 Prohibited Materials

Candidates are not allowed to carry any textual material, Calculators, DocuPen, Slide Rules, Log Tables and Electronic Watches with facilities of calculator, printed or written material, bits of papers, mobile phone, Blue-tooth devices, pager or any other electronic gadget/ device etc.

- The candidates are prohibited to bring any kind of electronic gadgets/device in the Examination room/hall.
- If any candidate is in possession of any of the above item, his/ her candidature will be treated as unfair means and lead to cancellation of the current Examination and also debar the candidate for future Examination(s) & the material will be seized.
- Smoking, chewing gutka, spitting etc. in the Examination Room/Hall is strictly prohibited.
- Instrument / Geometry / Pencil box, Handbag, Purse or Any kind of Paper/Stationery, Eatables / Snacks and Tea / Coffee / Cold drinks / Water (loose or packed), Mobile Phone / Ear Phone / Microphone / Pager / Calculator/ Camera /Tape Recorder, any metallic item or electronic gadgets etc. are NOT allowed in the Examination Room / Hall.

Note: Diabetic students will be allowed to carry eatables like sugar tablets / fruits (like banana / apple / orange) and transparent water bottle to the Examination Hall.

However, they will not be allowed to carry packed foods like chocolate / candy /sandwich etc.

CHAPTER – 8: Unfair Means Practices

8.1. Unfair Means Practices and Breach of Examination Rules

8.1.1 Definition: Unfair Means practice is an activity that allows a candidate to gain an unfair advantage over other candidates. It includes, but is not limited to:

- a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used for unfair practices including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, eatable items, ornaments or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the Examination in the paper concerned;
- b) Using someone to write Examination on his / her behalf (physical or virtual impersonation) or preparing material for copying;
- c) Writing the Exam at an Exam Centre other than the one allotted to him / her;
- d) Violating Examination rules or any direction issued by NTA in connection with GAT-B/BET 2026 Examination;
- e) Assisting other candidate to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance directly or indirectly of any kind or attempting to do so;
- f) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the Examination time in the Examination Centre;
- g) Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the Examination or threatening any of the candidates;
- h) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the Examination;
- i) Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. Admit Card, Rank Letter, Self-Declaration, etc.;
- j) Forceful entry/exit from Examination Centre/Hall;
- k) Use or attempted use of any electronic device after entering the Examination Centre;
- l) Affixing/ uploading of wrong/ morphed photographs/signatures on the Application Form/ Admit Card/ Proforma;
- m) Creating obstacles in smooth and fair conduct of Examination;
- n) In possession of bits of paper
- o) Not attempting the question paper for long time intervals;
- p) Fidgeting and looking here and there;
- q) Availing of the service of a scribe and/ or compensatory time without processing the extent of disability that warrants the use of service and/ or grant of compensatory time;
- r) Any candidate with more than one Application Number (more than one SCORE CARDS) will be treated as UFM, even if found at a later stage, and strict action will be taken against that Candidate.
- s) Any other malpractices declared as Unfair Means by the NTA;
- t) An offence punishable under the Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 2024.

Disclaimer- The decision of the NTA shall be final and binding in determining whether any individual or candidate is guilty of committing any of the aforementioned or similarly classified offences under Unfair Means (UFM) cases.

8.1.2 Punishment for using Unfair means practices

During the course of or before or after the Examination, if a candidate is found indulging in any of the practices as defined above, he/she shall be deemed to have used Unfair means practice(s) and booked under UNFAIRMEANS (U.F.M.) Case. The candidate could be debarred for 3 years in future and shall also be liable for criminal action and /or any other action as deemed fit.

8.1.3 Cancellation of Result

The result GAT-B/BET 2026 of the candidate(s) who indulge in Unfair means Practices will be cancelled and will not be declared. Similarly, the result of those candidates who appear from the Centre other than the one allotted to them or allow another candidate/person to write the examination on his behalf will be cancelled. No plea will be entertained in this regard.

CHAPTER – 9: Procedure of Declaration of Result.

9.1. Display of Recorded Responses

The NTA will display the Recorded Responses and Question Paper attempted by the candidates towards both the examinations on the NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/gat-bet/> prior to declaration of result. The recorded responses are likely to be displayed for two to three days.

A Public Notice in this regard informing the date/s when the window will open will be hosted on the NTA website.

9.2 Display of Provisional Answer Key for Challenges

NTA will display Provisional Answer Key of the questions towards both the examinations on the NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/gat-bet/>, to provide an opportunity to the candidates to challenge the Provisional Answer Key. The Answer Keys are likely to be displayed for two to three days. Candidates will be given an opportunity to make a challenge online against the Provisional Answer Key, on payment of **Rs. 200/-** per challenged question, as a non-refundable processing fee.

Only paid challenges made during stipulated time through key challenge link will be considered. The subject experts will examine all the challenges received and then a final answerkey will be displayed and declared.

The NTA decision on the challenges shall be final and no further communication will be entertained. NTA will not inform the candidates individually about their challenges. The result will be compiled on the basis of the Final Answer Key declared. No grievance with regard to Answer Key(s) after Declaration of Result of GAT-B 2026 and BET– 2026 will be entertained.

9.3 Procedure and Criteria for Declaration of Result

- Negative marking for wrong answers, wherever required, shall be applicable as per scheme of Exam.
- If a question for any reason is found to be wrong, the benefit of marks will be given to only those candidates who attempted the question.
- On examining the challenges by the subject experts, if it is found that along with the original answer key one more option(s) is correct, then marks will be awarded to all those candidates who have attempted any one of the correct options.

The result for GAT-B 2026 and BET 2026 will be processed based on Final Answer Keys. No grievance with regard to Answer Key(s) after Declaration of Result of GAT-B 2026 and BET 2026 will be entertained. The marks obtained by a candidate will be considered further for computation of the result of both GAT-B 2026 and BET 2026. No Score Card will be dispatched to the candidates and the candidates are advised to download their Score Cards for GAT-B 2026 and BET 2026 from the website: <https://exams.nta.nic.in/gat-bet/> only.

Merely appearing and passing in GAT-B 2026 /BET 2026 or both does not confer any right to the candidate for admission to the participating institutions/universities or award of fellowship.

The selection and admission is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, rank in merit list, medical fitness, verification of original documents and such other criteria as may be prescribed by host institutions/universities.

➤ **Graduate Aptitude Test Biotechnology (GAT- B) 2026**

Based on the marks obtained by the candidates in GAT-B 2026, RCB/DBT shall announce the result. List of qualified candidates' details will be published in both DBT and RCB websites. Thereafter, the score and rank cards can be downloaded from the NTA website. Following declaration of GAT-B 2026 results, an all India categorywise merit list will be prepared as per Reservation Policy of Government of India. Call for admissions, for GAT-B 2026 qualified candidates, will be advertised separately by participating Institutions/ Universities as per institutional admission and selection norms. Reservation policy of Government of India will be followed for admissions to DBT supported Post Graduate Programmes in Biotechnology and allied areas at Participating Institutions/ Universities. Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB) and Department of Biotechnology (DBT) will not play any role and responsibility in the admission and selection process (transfer/cancellation/conversion of seats/fee refund policy) of Participating Institutions/Universities.

➤ **Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026**

Based on the performance in Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2026, two categories of Merit List shall be prepared (Category-I and Category-II). Government of India norms for reservation will be followed for shortlisting of candidates. Candidates shortlisted under Category-I shall be eligible to avail fellowship at any recognized University/Institution across India, where the candidate enrolls for Ph.D. Programme. Candidates selected under Category-II will be eligible to be appointed in any DBT sponsored project with fellowship equivalent to NET/GATE qualification as per current DST guidelines and/or enroll in PhD programme, subject to selection through institutional selection process. Selection in Category-II shall not entitle candidate for any fellowship from DBT-JRF programme.

9.4 Re-Evaluation/Re-Checking of result

There shall be no re-evaluation/re-checking of the result. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.

CHAPTER – 10: General / Miscellaneous Provisions

10.1 Procedure for appearing in Computer Based Test (CBT)

Please read the detailed procedures for Computer Based Test (CBT) provided at **Appendix-V**.

10.2 Caution Notice and Non-Disclosure Agreement

10.2.1 Caution Notice

- a) Candidates are advised to refer to GAT-B/BET 2026 website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/gat-bet/> for authentic information and periodic updates about GAT-B/BET 2026.
- b) Candidates are advised not to be allured by various claims of any party or person or institute for qualifying GAT-B/BET 2026 securing seat.
- c) Candidates are advised to bring any such information to the notice to NTA by email on dbt@nta.ac.in .

10.2.2 Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)

- a) GAT-B/BET 2026 is a proprietary Examination and is conducted by NTA. The contents of this exam are confidential, proprietary and are owned by NTA/ RCB and explicitly prohibits the candidate from publishing, reproducing or transmitting any or some contents of this test, in whole or in part, in any form or by any means, verbal or written, electronic or mechanical or through Hangouts, Blogs etc. using either one's own account or proxy account(s), for any purpose.
- b) By registering for the GAT-B/BET 2026, candidates are covered by Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA). As per NDA, candidates cannot disclose any question or contents of question paper in part or otherwise with any person or party or website or such other media/publication. Any act in breach of the NDA shall be liable for penal action as per law. Kindly note that this is a punishable offence and shall lead to cancellation of candidature.
- c) Violation of any act or breach of the same shall be liable for penal action and cancellation of the candidature at the bare threshold.

- d. Any information which in the opinion of NTA cannot be revealed.

12.3 NTA Weeding Out Rules

The record of GAT-B/BET 2026 will be preserved up-to 90 days from the date of declaration of result.

12.4 Legal Jurisdiction

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of GAT-B/BET 2026 Examinations including results shall fall within the jurisdiction of Delhi / New Delhi only. Further, any legal question arising out of the Examination shall be entertained only when raised within 30 days from the declaration of result.

The Director (Administration) of the NTA shall be the official by whose designation the NTA may sue or be sued.

12.5 RTI

Information uploaded on the website shall not be provided to the candidate or any other person under R.T.I. Act, 2005. The information uploaded on the website shall remain for a specific period only. Therefore, the candidates are advised to download the uploaded information and keep with them for future. In due course of examination or in midway of process, neither any application under Right to Information Act, 2005 shall be entertained nor information will be provided.



PROCEDURE FOR APPEARING IN COMPUTER BASED TEST (CBT)

1. A computer terminal (node) indicating Roll Number will be allocated to each candidate. Candidates should find and sit on their allocated computers only. Any candidate found to have changed room/hall or the computer on their own rather than the one allotted would be liable to cancellation of candidature and no plea in this regard would be entertained.
2. The computer terminal allotted to the candidate will display Welcome login screen, Candidate's photograph and name of the examination
3. The candidate shall be able to see the detailed instructions for the examination. Candidates are advised to go through the instructions carefully regarding the type of questions and Marking Scheme. At the designated time of start of the examination, the candidates will be able to proceed.
4. Candidate login page will be displayed on the screen, for login candidate has to enter the password.
5. Invigilator will instruct the candidate to start the test on the scheduled start time of exam.
6. The keyboard attached to the computer will be disabled during the entire duration of the examination.
7. During examination, screen will continuously display the remaining time at its top right hand corner.






