Subject: NTA Declares the Result/NTA Scores of Common University Entrance Test (UG) - 2026 - reg.

The National Testing Agency has been entrusted by the Ministry of Education and University Grants Commission (UGC) to conduct the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission into Undergraduate Programmes in Central Universities under the Ministry of Education, and other participating Universities/ Institutions/ Organizations/ Autonomous Colleges.

2. The CUET (UG) provided a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organizations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country especially those from rural and other remote areas, to help establish better connections with the Universities. A single Examination enabled the Candidates to cover a wide outreach and be part of the admissions process to various Central Universities and other participating Universities.

3. The National Testing Agency conducted the Common University Entrance Test (UG) - 2026 [CUET (UG) - 2026] in computer-based test (CBT) mode for **15,68,867** (Fifteen lakh sixty eight thousand eight hundred and sixty seven) **unique registered candidates**. Each candidate had flexibility to choose up to **five** subjects. This generated an aggregate of approximately **67,56,327 test instances**, produced **12,906 distinct subject combinations**, with the test conducted across **19 days/35 shifts** nationwide as well as international locations to accommodate this scale and diversity while preserving examination integrity.

4. The CUET (UG) - 2026 was conducted for admission in the academic session 2026-27 in CBT mode as per the following details:

5. The CUET (UG) – 2026 provided access and flexibility in the following ways:

- In total, 37 subjects (13 languages, 23 domain-specific subjects, 01 General Aptitude Test) were offered to the candidates in the CUET (UG)-2026. Candidates could choose up to a maximum of five (05) subjects, including languages and the General Aptitude Test.
- 332 unique question papers (18,160 unique Questions) and 996 total question papers including 13 languages (55,055 questions) were administered over a period of 19 days in 35 shifts.
- The medium of the question paper was in 13 following languages - English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.
- The CUET (UG) - 2026 was conducted in 321 exam cities, including 13 cities outside the country in Abu Dhabi, Doha, Kathmandu, Kuala Lumpur, Kuwait City, Lagos, Manama, Muscat, Riyadh, Sharjah, Singapore, West Java, and Washington.

6. The role of NTA, in conduct of CUET(UG)-2026 is confined to the registration of candidates, conduct of the test, hosting of answer keys, inviting challenges, finalizing answer keys, preparing and declaring results, and hosting the score card. The merit list is prepared by participating Universities/organizations. Universities also decide about their individual counselling based on the score card of CUET (UG) - 2026 provided by NTA.

This reflects an increase of more than 15% in the total number of registered candidates and approximately 20% in the number of female candidates. Notably, the gender gap in registrations has narrowed compared to 2025, indicating a relatively higher participation of female candidates this year.


