

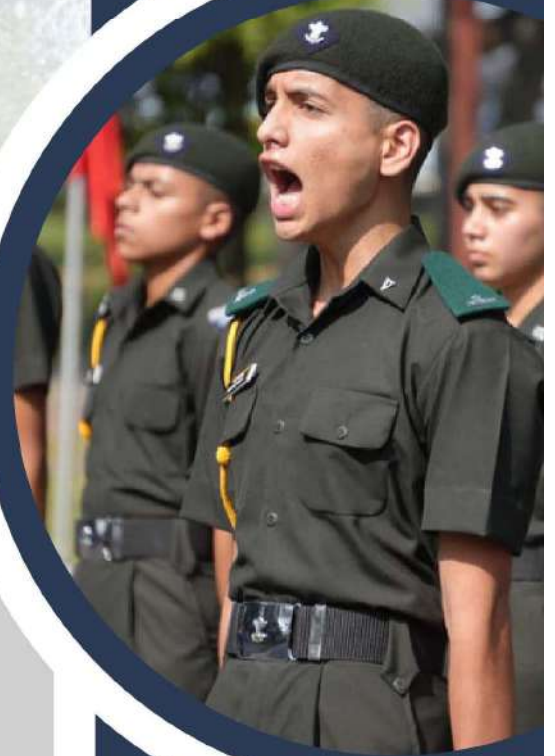

INTRODUCTION

ABOUT NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY (NTA).

The Ministry of Education (MOE), Government of India (GOI) has established National Testing Agency (NTA) as an independent autonomous and self-sustained premier examining organization under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 for conducting efficient, transparent and international standards exams in order to assess the competency of candidates for admissions to premier higher educational institutions.

The objectives of NTA, inter-alia, include: -

- (a) To conduct efficient, transparent and international standard exams in order to assess the competency of candidates for admission.
- (b) To undertake research on educational, professional and examining system to identify gaps in the knowledge systems and take steps for bridging them.
- (c) To produce and disseminate information and research on education and professional development standards.

1. **RIMCEE-2026** will be conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).
2. The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting online applications, operating the online application portal, conducting Stage-I (Written Examination), initial scrutiny of applications for issuance of Admit Cards, processing/evaluation and declaration of the Stage-I result, and providing the processed merit data to RIMC. RIMC remains responsible for framing and administering eligibility, vacancy, reservation/merit and admission criteria; Stage-II Viva Voce, medical examination, final merit/selection and admission; and final verification of original documents and eligibility at subsequent stages.

*Candidates belonging to the **Other Backward Classes–Non-Creamy Layer (OBC-NCL)** category must ensure that their caste/community is included in the **Central List of Other Backward Classes (OBC)** available on the website of the **National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC)** at www.ncbc.nic.in, as on the first day of the month in which the online admission process for RIMC commences. Candidates whose caste/community is included in the said **Central List of OBC** may select “**OBC-NCL**” as their category while filling out the Online Admission Form. Candidates belonging to the **OBC-NCL category as per the State/UT list**, but whose caste/community is **not included in the Central List of OBC**, must **not** select “**OBC-NCL**”. Such candidates shall select “**Un-Reserved (UR)**” as their category.

Note: -The fee as mentioned above is exclusive of any taxes or service charges payable to banks/ payment organizations, that may be applicable. No request for refund of the examination fee once successfully remitted will be entertained by NTA, except in the case of duplicate or multiple payments arising from the same application. Such duplicate payments will be refunded automatically through the original payment mode after fee reconciliation by NTA, generally after declaration of the final result.

CHAPTER 3**ADMISSION GUIDELINES**

1. **ADMISSION**. Candidates are advised to go through the following Admission Guidelines/procedure hosted on the website of the RIMC and understand the procedure clearly. The vacancies are subject to revision. These guidelines will help to understand the admission and selection process without problems and difficulties.

1.1 RIMC is an Institution of National importance, providing quality all round education to young boys & girls to prepare them to become Military Leaders. Since its inception on 13 March 1922, RIMC has produced four Chiefs of Army Staff and two Chief of the Air Staff in India and three in Pakistan. Besides these, it has produced a host of other senior officers of General/Flag/Air rank, and continues to do so. 1.2 To pursue a career in the Armed Forces, the boys & girls after spending five years at RIMC and passing the XII CBSE Board examination, have to also qualify in an All-India written examination conducted by the UPSC and an interview by the Services Selection Board to join the National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla, for a three-year degree course. This is followed by further professional training in the academies of the Army, Navy and Air Force, before being commissioned as an officer of the Armed Forces by the President of India.

1.3 The RIMC has two academic terms in a year from **17 January to 31 May** (Spring term) and from **17 July to 30 November** (Autumn term). The periods in between are for vacations. The number of vacancies for term shall be as approved by the competent authority and notified before/ at the commencement of the admission process. Admissions are conducted bi-annually under a state-wise/ zone-wise merit system, featuring a tentative term-wise intake of 25 vacancies for boy cadets and 10 vacancies for girl cadets per term. Entrance to RIMC is decided purely on merit and on the basis of an all India written examination followed by an interview of select candidates and a medical examination of candidates who qualify in the interview and are in merit. Details of examination etc. are advertised well in advance in leading national newspapers.

2. **PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR RIMCEE-2026**

The procedure for filling the Online Application Form, Payment of Fee and uploading of document has been given in Chapter-6. It is advised to read and understand the procedure carefully before filling up the Application Form.

3. **GENERAL INFORMATION**

3.1 **Fee:** Fees at RIMC are heavily subsidized by the Central Govt. The annual fee is Rs. 1,48,650/- for General Candidates and Rs. 1,31,850/- for SC/ST Candidates except for the first year. Various State Government grant generous scholarship to meritorious students.

3.2 The fee structure may be revised periodically. Details of the annual fee for the first year are as under: -

- (i) **Faculty:** There is a highly professional faculty at RIMC appointed by a rigorous selection process conducted by the UPSC. They are Government gazetted officers and are very qualified in their respective subjects. The teacher student ratio is 1:12.5, which enables them to give a personal attention at all times.
- (ii) **Boarding and Lodging:** Cadets live in dormitories, which fosters a spirit of camaraderie and esprit-de-corps. They all dine together in the Cadet's Mess where good, nutritious and wholesome food is provided in a clean and healthy environment.
- (iii) **Medical:** There is a 10 bedded Hospital with a Doctor available round the clock, for out-patients as well as for those requiring admission. Serious cases are referred to the Military Hospital, Dehradun Cantt.
- (iv) **Counselling:** There are experienced Section Masters available for regular counselling of the cadets on problems faced by them during the teenage adolescence.
- (v) **Library:** There is a well-stocked good library having around 20000 books and many newspapers and magazines to provide every opportunity for intellectual growth.
- (vi) **Co-curricular Activities:** There are abundant facilities to promote hobbies and enrich the social and cultural life of the boys. This complements the academic curriculum. Notable amongst them are riding, rifle shooting, art, craft, aero modelling, Young Newtons, Alchemists, Mountaineering, White water rafting, Skiing, Golf, Nature Club etc, some of whose pictorial details you would have observed in the Prospectus.
- (vii) The RIMC reserves the right for any modification/addition/deletion in terms & conditions over and above.

4. GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT EXAMINATION

4.1 **AGE LIMITS.**

- (i) Admission to Class VIII will be through RIMCEE-2026 for the Term commencing July 2027.
- (ii) Admission to RIMC is strictly for Class VIII and is offered twice a year - January and July terms.
- (iii) Admission is based on the performance of candidates in the Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC) Entrance Examination-2026. The admission of candidates will be carried out on the basis of performance of the candidate in all the Stages of the Exam.
- (iv) For Admission in Spring term of a particular year - For admission in January Term the candidates should not be less than (12 ½) twelve years and six months and not more than fourteen (14) years old as on 1 January of the year the candidate seeks admission to RIMC. Entrance for the same is conducted during the month of June of the previous year.

- (v) For Admission in Autumn term of a particular year - For admission in July Term candidates should not be less than (12 ½) twelve years and six months and not more than fourteen (14) years old as on 1 July of the year the candidate seeks admission to RIMC. Entrance Examination for the same is conducted during the month of December of previous year.

For example, if the candidate appears:

- (vi) For RIMCEE-2026 examination conducted in December 2026, the eligible DOB ranges between 02 July 2013 to 01 January 2015, both dates inclusive.

5. EDUCATION QUALIFICATIONS

RIMC begins its academic session from Class VIII. Therefore, at the time of admission, candidates should have been studying in Class VII or passed Class VII from a recognized School.

6. LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION

The last date for submission of the Online Application Form for the Entrance Examination to be held in December 2026 is **30 September 2026**. The last date for late submission of the Online Application Form with a **late fee** is **07 October 2026**. The Notification in this regard is available on the official website of the NTA at <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RIMCEE/>.

7. EXAMINATION CITY / CENTRES

Examination Centres are generally located in the state capitals or in cities/towns as advertised. (For details of Exam City, candidates are advised to refer to Chapter-9).

8. EXAMINATION SCHEDULE.

Schedule of examination and interview is given below:

- (a) For Admission in July 2027 term - the Stage-I written examination will be conducted on 06 December 2026. Stage-II Viva Voce is tentatively scheduled for April 2027; the exact date and venue will be announced separately on the official NTA/RIMC website.
- (b) For details about Exam and its Stages, candidates are advised to refer to Chapter-7.
- (c) It is mandatory to pass all the Stages of the Examination, i.e. Written Examination, Viva Voce and Medical Exam separately.

9. ADMIT CARD/HALL TICKETS

Admit card/Hall tickets will be issued by the National Testing Agency through its official Website: <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RIMCEE/>. Candidates are advised to visit the official websites regularly for latest updates for various activities. For details refer, "Important Information at a Glance under Chapter-2 of the Information Bulletin.

10. **PASS/CUT OFF PERCENTAGE&CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION, INTERVIEW AND MEDICAL BOARD**

It is mandatory to pass all the Stages of the Examination, i.e. Written Examination, Viva Voce and Medical Exam separately. For details, refer Chapter-7.

11. **CHECK LIST OF DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED**

Please refer Chapter 6 and upload the desired documents while filling up the Application Form Online. It is advised to go through the instructions given therein carefully:

- (a) Scanned images of Candidate's Photograph (file size: 10kb to 200 kb) in JPG/JPEG format.
- (b) Date of Birth Certificate (issued by Municipal Corporation/Gram Panchayat) (file Size: 50kb to 300kb in pdf format).
- (c) Domicile Certificate of the Candidate (file Size: 50kb to 300kb in pdf format)
- (d) SC/ST Certificate (where applicable) (file Size: 50kb to 300kb in pdf format).
- (e) Candidate's Left Hand Thumb Impression in JPG/JPEG format in 10kb to 50kb
- (f) School Studying Certificate. A certificate from the Principal of the current school in which the student is studying, with photograph attested stating the date of birth (as per the school records) and the class in which the candidate is studying (file Size: 50kb to 300kb in pdf format).

12. **SYLLABUS OF RIMC ENTRANCE EXAMINATION**

Syllabus is as prescribed by the RIMC. The RIMC Entrance Examination is designed to assess the candidate's academic aptitude and suitability for a rigorous training environment. The syllabus is aligned with the learning standards of Classes VI and VII CBSE/ NCERT and the broader topics have been given in the Chapter 8.

13. **PROMULGATION OF RESULTS**

13.1 Results of successful candidates who qualify for Stage-II Viva Voce will be promulgated on the RIMC website after completion of Stage-I processing and approval by the competent authority. The successful candidates will appear for the Viva Voce at the place/state of domicile or other permitted location as specified in the application and notified by RIMC.

13.2 Candidates are responsible to regularly check the website for latest status update. It is mandatory for all the selected candidates to join RIMC as per timeline mentioned, on receipt of the Joining Instructions. Joining Instructions will be sent to email ID as mentioned in Application Form by the candidates.

14. **FINAL MERIT LIST**

After completion of interview of the short-listed candidates a state wise Merit List and an All-India Merit List is prepared out of those candidates who pass in the interview. Thereafter, all the selected and reserve candidates are called for medical examination.

15. JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

15.1 Candidates finally selected for admission to the RIMC would be sent the joining instructions before the joining date, they are required to arrive at Dehradun for admission formalities.

15.2 It is not possible to lay down precise standards for Height, Weight, Chest measurements and eyesight standards for these candidates but the Medical Board will be guided in their assessment by the physical standards for admission to the National Defence Academy.

16. ADVERTISEMENT

Notwithstanding the guidelines contained in the previous paragraphs about eligibility criteria, last date of submission of application form, examination centres / schedules, promulgation of results etc. Details as promulgated in the Government Notification takes precedence. Please go by the details as advertised.

17. WHOM TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION FORM

The Application Form submitted online through the official Website only i.e <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RIMCEE/> will be accepted. No other mode of submitting the Application Form is permitted except the Online mode during the Application submission period. Candidates are advised to refer to Chapter 6 for more details.

CHAPTER 4**RESERVATION AND MERIT CRITERIA**

1. Admission to RIMC is strictly merit based and there is no reservation policy in the selection of candidates.
2. Candidates are selected against the state wise pre-allocated number of seats against each state and UTs.

3. **State-wise Merit for Boys.**

The merit list for boys is to be prepared separately for each State/UT, based on the examination results. While a consolidated All India Merit List is generated, however, the allocation of vacancy is undertaken against pre-allocated state-wise vacancy as applicable, which are to be notified in advance in notification.

4. **All India and Zonal Merit for Girls.**

For girl candidates, a consolidated All India Merit List is generated based on cumulative exam scores. The final seat allotment is executed on a Zone-wise basis across the five designated geographic zones (North, South, East, West, and Central) to ensure equitable regional distribution. Girl cadets are selected against zonal seat allocations, as detailed below:

CHAPTER 5**GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS****GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.**

1. **RIMCEE-2026** will be conducted as per the guidelines of the RASHTRIYA INDIAN MILITARY COLLEGE.
2. Merely appearing and passing in **RIMCEE-2026** does not confer any right to the candidate for admission to the Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC).
3. The selection and admission to Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC) is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, rank in merit list, medical fitness, verification of original documents and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC).
4. Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates will be further debarred from appearing in future examinations.
5. Incomplete application and applications not in accordance with instructions are liable to be rejected without any further intimation.
6. The examination fee once deposited will not be refunded. Fee will neither be carried forward to a future examination nor refunded.
7. Applications once submitted cannot be withdrawn. It must be noted that mere deduction of fee from the bank account is not a proof of fee payment. The payment should be supported by fee payment and generation of Confirmation Page.
8. Instructions in the Information Bulletin may change /be updated based on decisions taken by the NTA / RIMC and other authorities from time to time. Therefore, it is advised to regularly check the website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RIMCEE/> any further updates or information.
9. NTA/RIMC retain the statutory authority to amend vacancy numbers, alter the examination structure, and establish minimum qualifying cut-off marks, subject to administrative approvals. All declared vacancies remain provisional and contingent upon institutional requirements. Candidates are legally bound to comply strictly with all issued directives and guidelines throughout the RIMCEE.
10. NTA / RIMC reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently, if any, to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the **RIMCEE-2026**, even though the Admit Card had been issued by the NTA.
11. Candidates are required to keep with them at least one identity proof along with the admit card issued to the candidate and shall produce the same on demand at the time of examination at the center.
12. Candidate's admission to **RIMCEE-2026** is purely provisional and is subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria prescribed by the Rashtriya Indian Military College as applicable.
13. Application Form of candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria shall be rejected.
14. Selection of a candidate in the Examination is provisional, subject to being found otherwise eligible for selection.

15. The decision of RIMC shall be final in all matters relating to Eligibility, Acceptance or Rejection of the applications/ candidature of any Candidate, Penalty for false information, Selection & Admission in RIMC etc.
16. In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/terms/rules/criteria regarding determination of eligibility/conduct of examination/registration of candidates/information contained therein, the interpretation of the RIMC shall be final and binding in accordance with the applicable rules.
17. Candidates are advised to keep visiting the NTA website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RIMCEE/> and RIMC website <https://rimc.edu.in> regularly for all examination related updates and to check their emails.
18. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry Hand bag, Purse, cap, goggles, jackets, any kind of Paper/ Stationery/ Textual material (printed or written material), Eatables (loose or packed), Mobile Phone/ Ear Phone/ Microphone/Pager, Calculator, Docu-Pen, Slide Ruler, Formulae, Log Tables, whitener, Camera, Tape Recorder, Electronic Watches with facilities of calculator, any metallic item or electronic gadgets/devices, pointed instruments etc. in the Examination Hall/ Room.
19. A candidate needs to give her/his preferences for examination city/centres during submission of online application form. However, centres shall be allocated taking into account logistical considerations.
20. The information about the examination centres will be given in the respective admit cards.
21. No request for change of centre/venue/date/session for Examination shall be entertained.
22. NTA/RIMC, however, reserves the right to cancel any of the Examination Centres and/ or add some other Centres, with approval of competent authority, depending upon the response, administrative feasibility, etc.
23. NTA/RIMC also reserves the right to allot the candidate to any centre even other than the preferences given by her/him.
24. Candidate will appear for the examination at an Examination Centre at her / his own risks and expenses and NTA/RIMC will not be responsible for any injury or losses etc. of any nature.
25. No TA/DA will be paid to any candidate including SC/ST candidates for appearing in the examinations.
26. In case it is found at any time in future that the candidate has used / uploaded the photograph and signature of someone else in her/his Application Form /Admit Card or she/he has tampered her/his Admit Card /result, these acts of the candidate shall be treated as Unfair Means (UFM).
27. In case, it is detected at any stage of examination that a candidate does not fulfill the eligibility norms and/or that she/he has suppressed/twisted or truncated any material acts or any other grounds which the NTA/RIMC consider to be sufficient clause, her/his candidature shall stand cancelled without giving any reasons and notice to the candidate concerned. If any of these shortcomings is detected even after selection/admission, their admission may be liable to be terminated.
28. No recommendation for selection either written or oral, other than those for whom required as per Rules applicable will be taken into consideration. Any attempt on the part of a candidate to enlist support directly or indirectly for his candidature by other means shall disqualify him/ her for selection/admission.

29. The candidates are required to fill in the Online Application Form with correct and complete information carefully. If any incomplete or false information is given, then the candidate will be solely responsible for the same and on the basis of false and incomplete information, the Application Form shall be rejected at any stage of the selection without giving any reasons/notice. On furnishing any false information, particulars, certificates or indicating wrong category/sub-category etc. in the application form or in case of any other default, NTA/RIMC may reject the candidature at any stage of the selection/admission.
30. Requests for information under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act 2005) shall be dealt with by the designated competent authority in accordance with the provisions of the Act and applicable rules. Information may be withheld only to the extent permitted under the applicable statutory exemptions. The information uploaded on the website shall remain for a specific period only. Therefore, the candidates are advised to download the uploaded information and keep up with them for future.
31. It is to be noted that if a candidate has been allowed to appear in the examination, it does not imply that the candidate's eligibility has been verified. It does not vest any right with a candidate for selection/admission. The eligibility is subject to final verification by the RIMC at subsequent stages. The candidate shall satisfy her/his eligibility before applying and shall be personally responsible in case she/he is not eligible to apply as per the given eligibility criteria on the last date for submission of Application Form.
32. Furnishing of false, wrong or inaccurate information may lead to cancellation of the candidature of the Applicant and/or her/his Result. Canvassing in any form and use of Unfair Means (UFM) during the examinations shall disqualify the candidature of the applicant.
33. The Result of the Candidates who indulge in Unfair Means (UFM) practices shall not be declared (and may be cancelled)

36. NTA/RIMC reserves the right to conduct additional examination (as applicable) at any stage in accordance with the applicable rules and with approval of competent authority. Furthermore, RIMC also reserves the right to cancel modify, or suspend any part or the entirety of the selection and admission process across all notified stages, in this Information Bulletin at its discretion and without liability.

10. Scanned clear signature in JPG/JPEG format clearly legible (size between 10kb to 50kb).
11. Service certificate (for wards of defence personnel/ govt/ transferrable job applying for Centre other than domicile) in pdf format (size between 50kb to 300kb).
12. A valid e-mail ID as important communications will be made in this e-mail ID.
13. A valid mobile number as important information via SMS will be sent to this number.
14. **Mobile Number and e-mail Address:** Candidates must provide Mobile Number and email address (their own or that of their parents). The Mobile Number and email will be verified through One Time Password (OTP) prior to creation of online credential.
15. Information Bulletin may be downloaded and read carefully by the candidate that to be sure about his/her eligibility and to acquaint with requirements for submission of Online Application Form.

2. Uploading of scanned images:

Candidate's Photograph: to be uploaded

- (a) Passport size Photograph (size: 10kb to 200kb) in JPG format.
- (b) The photographs must be taken on or after 1st July 2026 preferably indicating clearly the name of candidate along with the date of taking the photograph. Photograph should not be with cap or goggles. The focus needs to be on face (80% face coverage, ears clearly visible, on white background)
- (c) Spectacles are allowed only if being used regularly.
- (d) Polaroid and Computer-generated photos are not acceptable.
- (e) Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected.
- (f) Application without photographs shall be rejected.
- (g) The photographs need not be attested. Candidates are advised to keep 6 to 8 passport size and colour photographs with white background.
- (h) Candidates may note that if the photographs uploaded are found to be fabricated or defaced or seem to be hand-made or computer made etc., the application of the Candidate will be rejected and the same will be considered as using Unfair Means (UFM) and the candidate would be dealt with accordingly.

4. Candidate's left hand thumb impression: To be uploaded

A candidate should affix his/her left-hand thumb impression on white paper with Blue Ink and scan for uploading. File size must be between 10kb and 50kb in JPG/JPEG format. Further, unclear left hand thumb impression in online application forms will also be rejected.

Note: Candidate must ensure that the uploaded images are clear and proper.

5. Uploading of other certificates.

Note: Both the Steps (Step-1 and Step-2) can be done together or at separate timings and Final Submit the application form.

Step 3: After completing Step II of online Application Form, candidates may remit the examination fee (Step III) by choosing the following options: -

- (a) Select Debit/Credit Card/Net-banking/UPI- Mode of Payment and Service Provider (Service/Processing charges per transaction & GST (as applicable) to be paid by the candidate) and complete the steps as instructed.
- (b) Print the Confirmation Page after completion of Step III i.e. payment through Debit/Credit card/ Net banking/UPI.
- (c) If candidate fails to complete all the steps up to Step III, the final submission of Online Application will remain incomplete and unsuccessful.

- The medium of Exam will be bilingual (English and Hindi) except the questions in English Language. There will be no negative marking.

- The viva-voce will be held for only those candidates who qualify the Written Exam.** The list will be sent to the respective State Governments by RIMC after approval from HQ ARTRAC. **The date for viva-voce** (designed primarily to test the **intelligence, personality, & communication skills** of candidates) **will be intimated later.**
- The intelligence and personality of the candidate will be tested in the Interview.** It is mandatory to pass the Interview as well. **50% Marks must be obtained.**

- (c) The wards of Central Government employees can take their exam and viva-voce at the place of posting of either employee or Domicile State, however, their candidature will be considered from their original Domicile State. **It is, therefore mandatory for such candidates to inform the Domicile State while submitting the application online.**
- (d) The constitution of the selection board is briefly mentioned in the Regulations Governing RIMC and shall be as follows, however, the RIMC reserves the right for any modifications at a later stage : -
- (i) Chief Secretary to the Government or in case the State Government so desires, any other Secretary of the State Government nominated by him.
 - (ii) Two Military officers. (One of them should not be below the rank of Lt Col or equivalent from Army, Air Force or Navy). These officers will be detailed as far as possible from the nearest Military Station and all expenses of TA and DA etc will be borne by the Government of India.
 - (iii) The State Director of Public Institutions or Director of Education or some senior officer nominated by him.
 - (iv) Where practicable, a member of the State Public Service Commission.

- (a) The candidates who qualify the written examination and viva-voce and are included in the medical call-up list shall undergo a Medical Examination at selected Military Hospitals and only the candidates found medically fit will be considered for selection and admission to the RIMC subject to merit and vacancy.
- (b) Medical Examination of all qualified candidates will be conducted at nearest selected Hospital in consonance with AFMSF-2 (VER 2002).

Medical Rules:

Medical Examination: The selected candidates post examination would have to undergo a medical examination, Information regarding medical examination to RIMC, Dehradun are given as under:

- (a) The medical examination of candidate for admission to RIMC, Dehradun will be carried out by a medical board at a Military/Air Force/Navy Hospital nearest to the residence of the candidate.
- (b) It is not possible to lay down precise standards for Height, Weight and Chest measurements for these candidates but the other medical standards should be at par with NDA standards. Medical authorities to endorse 'Fit for RIMC' at the time of Entrance Medical Board. Height and to an extent weight are constitutional qualities which are largely governed by heredity. Therefore, candidates whose parents are short stature and below normal weight may not eventually attain the minimum standard height and weight required for the Armed Forces. This point should, therefore, be borne in mind by the parents/guardians for such candidates before they seek admission at the RIMC for their children/wards.

(c) The minimum acceptable visual standards will be as under:-

- (i) Fundus & Media-To be healthy with no significant degenerative or other changes of myopia.
- (ii) Visual Fields-To be full in each eye.
- (iii) Binocular vision and stereopsis must be good.

Note: Mild trachoma, Stage III or IV, with regressive corneal pannus of not more than 1 to 2 mm may be accepted provided, in the opinion of the Specialist, exacerbation or deterioration are not likely.

(d) **It will be ensured that: -**

- (i) There is no evidence of weak constitution, imperfect development, serious malformation or obesity.
- (ii) There is no maldevelopment or impairment of function of the bones or joints.
- (iii) There is no malformation of the head, deformity from fracture or depression of the bones of the skull.
- (iv) There is no impaired hearing, discharge from or disease of either ear, unhealed preformation of the tympanic membranes or signs of acute or chronic suppurative otitis media or evidence of radical or modified radical mastoid operation.

Note: A soundly healed perforation without any impairment of the mobility of the drum and without impairment of hearing should not be a cause for rejection.

- (v) There is no disease of the bones or cartilages of the nose or nasal polyps or disease of the nasopharynx.
- (vi) There are no enlarged glands in the neck and other parts of the body and that the thyroid gland is normal.
- (vii) There is no disease of the throat, palate, tonsils or gums or disease or injury affecting the normal function of either and blood vessels. Note: Simple hypertrophy of the tonsils, if there is no history of attacks of tonsillitis, is not a cause of rejection.
- (viii) There is no sign of functional or organic disease of the heart and blood vessels.
- (ix) There is no evidence of pulmonary tuberculosis or previous history of this disease or any other chronic disease of the lungs.

Note: Scars of operations for the removal of tuberculosis glands are not a cause for rejection provided that there has been no active disease within the preceding 5 years and the chest is clinically and radiologically clear,

- (x) There is no evidence of any disease of the digestive system including any abnormality of the liver and spleen
- (xi) There is no hernia or tendency thereto. There is no hydrocele, or definite varicocele or any other disease or defect of the genital organs.

Note: A candidate who has been operated for hydrocele will be accepted if there are no abnormalities of the cord and testicle and there is no evidence of filariasis.

- (xii) There is no fistula and/or fissure of the anus or evidence of hemorrhoids.
- (xiii) There is no disease of the kidneys, cases showing albuminuria or glycosuria will not be accepted.
- (xiv) There is no disease of the skin unless temporary or trivial. Scars, which by their extent or position cause or are likely to cause disability or marked disfigurement are a cause for rejection.
- (xv) There is no active latent or congenital venereal disease.
- (xvi) There is no history or evidence of mental disease. Candidates suffering from epilepsy; incontinence of urine, or enuresis will not be accepted.
- (xvii) There is no squint or morbid condition of the eye of the-lids, which is liable to a risk of aggravation or recurrence.
- (xviii) There is no active trachoma or its complications.

Note: Remedial operations are to be performed prior to entry. No guarantee is given of ultimate acceptance and it should be clearly understood by the candidate that the decision whether an operation is desirable or necessary is one to be made by his private medical adviser. The Government will accept no liability regarding the result operation or any expense incurred.

5. Though, every effort will be made to allot a centre in one of the cities selected by the candidate, the NTA reserves its right to allot a centre in a city other than the candidate's choice. Allotment of centre's will be done by the computer and there will be no human intervention.
6. All efforts will be made by NTA to consider the comfort and convenience of candidates while allotting centres. However, Center/City allocation will depend upon technical and logistical feasibility. Candidates may have to travel to other Cities/States.

CHAPTER 10**BARRED ITEMS**

1. Candidates are not allowed to carry the following items inside the examination centre under any circumstances. Candidates will be subjected to extensive and compulsory frisking before entering the exam centre with the help of hand-held metal detectors.
 - (a) Any stationery item like textual material (printed or written) bits of papers, Plastic Pouch, calculator, scale, writing pad, pen drives, eraser, electronic pen or scanner etc.
 - (b) Any communication device like mobile phone, blue tooth, earphones, micro phone, pager, health band etc.
 - (c) Other items like wallet, goggles, handbags, belt, cap etc.
 - (d) Any watch or wristwatch, bracelet, camera etc.
 - (e) Any ornaments/metallic item.
 - (f) Any food item opened or packed.
 - (g) Any other item which could be used for unfair means, by hiding communication device like microchip, camera, Bluetooth device etc.
2. No arrangement will be made at the centres for keeping any articles, /items belonging to the candidates.
3. In case any candidate is found in possession of any of the barred items inside the centre it will be considered as use of Unfair Means and action will be taken against the candidate in accordance with the relevant provisions.

CHAPTER 11**INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES/PARENTS/GUARDIANS**

1. It is expected that parents/guardians will guide their wards appropriately on the following issues before leaving home for appearing in **RIMCEE**.
2. Candidates should avoid coming with more than one escort (parent/ guardian). Escorts shall remain outside the gate during the conduct of the examination.
3. Candidate will not be allowed to enter the exam centre after the gate closing time. Therefore, the candidate shall leave home well in advance, taking into consideration various factors such as traffic, location of the centre and weather conditions etc. It would be appropriate to visit the centre a day before the examination to confirm the location, distance etc. to avoid any problem of reaching late at the centre and then not being allowed to appear in the examination.
4. Candidate shall follow all the instructions and maintain discipline in the examination hall.
5. Candidate shall not breach any examination rule.
6. Candidate shall not use or promote any unfair means activity during the examination.
7. Candidate will not be allowed to leave the exam hall till the conclusion of the exam. Candidate is advised not to attend examination on an empty stomach.
8. In case the candidate finds another candidate using unfair means in the examination, the same shall be immediately informed to the invigilators on duty.
9. Candidate are permitted to bring only the following items, to the examination centre:
 - (a) Admit card (with Self Declaration on it downloaded from NTA website) with passport size photograph and thumb impression affixed on it.
 - (b) Valid and original Photo ID proof.
 - (c) Drinking water in a personal transparent water bottle.
 - (d) A simple transparent black/blue ball point pen only.
 - (e) Passport size photograph for affixing on the attendance sheet.
 - (f) A candidate shall not bring any barred items to the centre.
10. Candidate shall co-operate in frisking with the staff at Examination Centre.
11. Candidate will report at the centre at the time indicated on his/her admit card to make themselves available for compulsory frisking and completing other registration procedures.
12. Candidates are advised to regularly visit website <https://exams.nta.nic.in/RIMCEE/> also check registered email /SMS for any update regarding examination.
13. In case your ward is found breaching any of the above-mentioned rules, your ward will not be permitted to enter the examination centre and will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
14. If your ward indulges in any unwanted activities, he/ she shall be debarred from taking this examination as per rules and shall also be liable for criminal action and or any action as may be deemed fit by NTA.

CHAPTER 12**ADMIT CARD**

1. The Admit Card is issued provisionally to all the candidates, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility conditions.
2. Admit Card will be hosted on the NTA website approximately 05-07 days before the date of the examination. A city intimation slip will be available to the candidate 12-15 days before date of examination. Any change in this schedule will be notified on the official NTA website.
3. The candidate has to download the Admit Card from the NTA website using their login credentials and appear for the Examination at the allotted Centre, date and time as indicated in his/her Admit Card.
4. Admit card is not transferable to any other person. Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.
5. No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination centre, on Date and Timing other than that allotted to him/her in his/her Admit card.
6. In case candidate is unable to download Admit Card from the website, the candidate should approach the **NTA Help Line between 10:00 am and 05:00 pm**.
7. The candidates are advised to read the instructions on the Information Bulletin as well as on the Admit Card carefully and follow them during the conduct of the examination.

Note:

- (a) Candidate must be in possession of the Admit Card to appear in the examination.
- (b) Candidate may please note that Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- (c) In no case, the duplicate Admit Card for RIMCEE would be issued at the Examination Centres.
- (d) Candidate must not mutilate/disfigure the Admit Card or change any entry made therein.
- (e) The validity of the Admit Card is only up to the day of Examination. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Card in good condition for future reference.
- (f) No Admit Card shall be issued to the candidates whose Applications are found to be incomplete for any reason (including indistinct/ doubtful photographs/without uploaded signatures) or who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria for the examination.
- (g) Issue of Admit Card, however, shall not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of admission process.

CHAPTER 13**USE OF UNFAIR MEANS/ MALPRACTICE****1. DEFINITION**

1.1 Use of unfair means or malpractice allows a candidate to gain an undue advantage over other candidates. It includes, but is not limited to:

- (a) Being in possession of any item or article which has been prohibited or can be used unfairly, including any stationery item, communication device, accessories, eatable items, ornaments or any other material or information relevant or not relevant to the examination in the paper concerned;
- (b) Using someone to write examination (impersonation) or preparing material for copying;
- (c) Breaching examination rules or any direction issued by NTA from time to time in connection with the conduct of **RIMCEE** examination.
- (d) Assisting other candidates to engage in malpractices, giving or receiving assistance of any kind, directly or indirectly or attempting to do so;
- (e) Writing questions or answers on any material other than on the answer sheet given by the Centre Superintendent for writing answers;
- (f) Tearing of answer sheet, any page of the exam booklet etc.;
- (g) Contacting or communicating or trying to do so with any person, other than the Examination Staff, during the examination time in the Examination Centre;
- (h) Taking away the answer sheet out of the examination hall/room;
- (i) Smuggling out answer sheet or part thereof;
- (j) Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examination or threatening any of the candidates or using violence against anyone;
- (k) Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination;
- (l) Manipulation and fabrication of online documents viz. admit card, rank letter, self- declaration, etc.;
- (m) Forceful entry/exit in/from Examination Centre/Hall;
- (n) Use or attempted use of any electronic device after entering the Examination Centre;
- (o) Affixing/uploading of wrong/morphed photographs on the application form/admit card/proforma;
- (p) Erasing or obliterating any information printed on the answer sheet;

- (q) Providing incorrect information on the answer sheet;
- (r) Making fake claims by manipulating the responses in sheet uploaded on website for challenge before or after declaration of result.
- (s) Creating obstacles in smooth and fair conduct of examination or creating disturbance to others inside the examination hall/room/centre.
- (t) Making an approach or attempting to influence the outcome of the result after the examination.
- (u) Any other malpractice declared as unfair means by the NTA.

2. **PUNISHMENT FOR USING UNFAIR MEANS/MALPRACTICE**

2.1 During the course of, before or after the examination if a candidate indulges in any of the above or similar incident, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair practices and booked under UNFAIR MEANS (UFM) case. The candidate may be debarred from future exams.

3. **CANCELLATION OF RESULT**

- (a) The candidature and result of **RIMCEE** of the candidates who indulge in Unfair Means/ Malpractice will be cancelled and will not be declared.
- (b) Similarly, the result of those candidates who appear from the Centre other than the one allotted to them, write on the Exam booklet/ answer Sheet of other candidates or allow other candidates to write on their Exam Booklet/ answer Sheet will be cancelled (and will not be declared).

CHAPTER 14

POST EXAMINATION ACTIVITIES AND DECLARATION OF RESULT (STAGE-1)

PROCEDURE FOR DECLARATION OF RESULT

Evaluation and Declaration of Stage-I Results:

The NTA shall conduct the initial evaluation of examination scripts and subsequently submit the processed results to RIMC for onward submission to HQ ARTRAC for administrative approval. Upon receipt of formal approval from the competent authorities, the NTA will officially declare the Stage-I results through its dedicated online portal. The respective Score Card (Stage-I) can be downloaded by individual candidates through their login credential on the website. Concurrently, RIMC shall host the results on its official website and the shortlisted candidates will be called upon for Stage II – viva voce.

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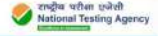
